**Annulments:** In response to Pope Francis' call for the annulment process to be free, the Diocese of Antigonish in conjunction with the Church of Canada has decreed that the annulment process will no longer charge any fees to those seeking annulments, and the Church will cover the entire costs. - (However, any donations towards the substantial cost of an annulment, borne by the Diocese, will be gratefully accepted). An annulment is not automatically granted in all cases, but most cases do receive the declaration of nullity. An annulment then allows the party to enter into a marriage recognized as valid by the Church. People in irregular unions are urged to take steps to make their union valid and holy according to Church teaching.
