**To date on Legal Settlement Account:** The Financial Legal Advisory Committee sent a Status Report to the pastors on April 9, 2010. They report that the parishes have been overwhelmingly positive in their responses, with net proceeds to the Settlement Account totaling in excess of \$4,500,000.00 to date. A number of parishes are still calculating their contribution and when this is done, pooling should amount to approximately \$6,000,000.00. In the coming months the Committee will begin the orderly liquidation of noncore assets of individual parishes (eg., Glebehouses not occupied by a pastor, land, etc.) At the conclusion of the legal process a full report will be circulated to parishes, in keeping with the principle of transparency.
